5th	5 days EXCLUSION FROM RONALD REAGAN
6th	10 days EXCLUSION FROM RONALD REAGAN
7th	10 days Recommendation to Opportunity School

UNIFORM VIOLATIONS

<u>Offense #</u>	<u>Consequence</u> - All will include Parent Contact.
1st	Warning & Change into Uniform
2nd	After School Detention & Change into Uniform
3rd	Saturday School & Change into Uniform
4th	1 day Indoor Suspension & Change into Uniform
5th	2 days Indoor Suspension & Excluded from Activities.
6th	2 days Indoor Suspension & Change into Uniform
7th	3 days Indoor Suspension & Change into Uniform
8th	5 days Indoor Suspension & Change into Uniform
9 th or more	10 days Indoor Suspension & Change into Uniform

TARDY TO CLASS

Each tardy to class will result in consequences in accordance with the classroom rules.
Excessive tardy to class will result in additional disciplinary action.

TARDY TO SCHOOL & HALL SWEEPS

<u>Offense Number</u>	<u>Consequence</u> - All will include Parent Contact.
1 st 2 nd 3 rd (Per Nine Weeks)	Report to designated area for a pass without penalty
4 th or 5 th	After School Detention
6 th and 7 th	Saturday School
8 th and 9 th	Two (2) days Indoor Suspension
10 or more	(3, 5, 7, or 10 days) Indoor Suspension

There is NO Excused Tardy to School.

Uniform and tardy hall sweeps will be conducted on a regular basis.

Students who have a total of six (6) days of suspension and/or 10 or more absences and/or 20 or more days tardy/ excused early will not be allowed to participate in extra-curricular activities.

The plan of action taken for all other violations will be in accordance to the Miami-Dade County Public Schools Code of Student Conduct. A student that has excessive tardies to school may have his/her credit withheld from the classes that the student does not attend regularly.
